Membership Rule

Article 1 (Purpose)

This rule shall apply to corporations, local governments, or individuals that become members under the General Incorporated Association Act (hereinafter referred to as "Members") pursuant to Chapter 2 of the Articles of Association of Carbon Recycling Fund Institute (hereinafter referred to as the "Association").

Article 2 (Membership categories)

- 1. The Members of the Association shall consist of the following four categories of Members for Regular Members and Supporting Members pursuant to the Articles of Association.
- 2. As for Regular Members, the following two categories shall be considered as Members:
 - (1) Corporate members: Corporations that joined by agreeing with the objectives and activities of the Association;
 - (2) Individual members: In principle, individuals belonging to corporations with 5 or fewer employees and individuals not belonging to any corporation, who joined by agreeing with the objectives and activities of the Association.
- 3. For Supporting Members, the following two categories shall be considered as Members:
 - (1) Local Government Members: Local governments that agree with the objectives of the Association and wish to cooperate with the activities of the Association:
 - (2) Academic Members: Schools, public research institutions, and academics and students that agree with the objectives of the Association and wish to cooperate with the activities of the Association.

Article 3 (Admission and Withdrawal)

- 1. A person who wishes to join the Association shall apply for membership using the form prescribed by the Association and obtain approval of the representative director.
- 2. Any Member who wishes to withdraw from membership shall submit a notice of withdrawal to the Association.

Article 4 (Membership Fee)

- 1. Each Member shall pay the membership fee to the designated account by the due date specified in the membership fee request.
- 2 The amount for each Member in one fiscal year shall be determined separately.
- 3 In principle, the full annual membership fee for the relevant fiscal year must be paid even if any Member joins the Association in the middle of the fiscal year.
- 4 Membership fee paid by Members shall be used for the operating expenses of the Association.
- 5 If any Member withdraws from membership, the membership fee already paid shall not be refunded.

Article 5 (Member Benefits)

- 1. Members may participate in grants for research conducted by the Association (with eligibility to contribute to the fund for research grants).
- 2. Members may participate in symposiums and other public relations activities conducted by the Association, as well as publicize your company's activities (with eligibility to contribute to the public relations fund).
- 3. Members may participate in various study activities conducted by the Association (with eligibility to view the results of various studies and other information through the website and study groups, etc.).
- 4 Members will have access to the latest information on carbon recycling.
- 5 Members can exchange information with Member companies each other.

Article 6 (Activities Report)

Members are entitled to receive from the Association a summary report of its activities each fiscal year.

Supplementary Provisions

These rules shall come into effect as from December 6, 2019.
